Reg. 1 Organisation

The 2016 FIM Rally is organised by: RIDERS, o.z.

On behalf of the Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM) and the Touring and Leisure Commission (CTL), the event will be held from 29th of June to 1st of July 2016 according to the FIM Code for Tourist Gatherings (hereafter known as CTG) – FIM Rally section; to the rules of the FIM, to these Supplementary Regulations (SR) and to the FIM Environmental Code.

Reg. 2 Participation in the FIM Rally

According to the FIM Code for Touristic Gatherings (Rally: Art. 2&4).

Reg. 3 Entries

Reg. 3.1 - Individual entries will be made on the form available for this purpose (or the duplicate) which will be delivered to the FMNs by the organiser (CTG Rally Art.5). The FMNs will return the entry forms to the Organiser after verification (see address in Reg. 1.1).

Reg. 3.2 - The FMNs will also add a summary list (excel sheet (s), provided by CTL) containing the following information:

- Names of participants
- The sum paid for the entry fees and accommodation (hotel and camping)
- The names and addresses of the participants' motorcycle clubs
- The distance from the headquarters of the clubs to the Rally centre
- The name, licence number and e-mail address of the National Delegate(s)





Reg. 4 Entry fee

The entry fee is fixed by the Federation of the participant. This is composed of the organiser's fee 165.00 € plus any administrative expenses which may be added by the FMN. The amount is fixed in EUROS (€).

The transfer costs are to be paid by the expeditor.

The FIM Rally is free of charge for children under 8 years old. Children between 8 and 12 years benefit from a discount of 50 %.

The entry fee will be paid in full (100%) by FMNs of the participants before 15th of March 2016 to the following account:

Reg. 5 Closing date for entries

The deadline for entries and the booking of the accommodation is the 15th of March 2016 after this date will be charged additional charge+ 25%.

Reg. 6 Gifts, souvenirs and services for the participants

- Every participant who has paid the registration fee receives the following minimal benefits:
- a bag containing souvenir gift(s) and a medal or plaque
- excursion(s) in the vicinity
- an entertainment programme
- 3 evening meals and 2 picnic(s) (CTG Rally Art.6).

Reg. 7 Accommodation

- 100% of the campsite booking fee will be paid with the registration.

- 100% of the hotel booking fee will be paid with the registration.

The hotel or camping bookings will be made on the „accommodation” booking form. The amounts due for the accommodation will be paid at the same time as the registration fee, i.e. before 15th of March 2016 to the bank account quoted in Reg.4.

All payments will be in Euros (€) and will cover the transfer costs.

Reg. 8 Optional Benefit

Bookings for these optional excursions must be made at the same time as the registration on the special form provided.

These trips are also to be paid before 15th of March 2016.

Reg.9 Welcome Centre

The welcome Centre will be open on 25th of June 2016 to 2nd of July 2016

On arrival day, each participant will receive information concerning the gathering place from which each national team will pass by the Arrival Control.

The entry papers and vehicles of the participants will be checked at the Welcome Centre upon arrival. The FIM Meritum and Co-Meritum stamps will also be distributed at this time.

Participants will receive a “classification card” similar to their ID card which MUST be handed over at the Arrival Control.

Reg. 10 Arrival Control

The Arrival Control will be operational on 29th of June 2016 from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM at the centre of Liptovský Mikuláš

In order to be classified, participants must hand over the “classification card” distributed earlier at the Welcome Centre. Neither copies nor the original entry forms will be accepted or counted for the classification.

Reg. 11 Closed Park (Parc Fermé)

After the control, the motorbikes will stay in the Closed Park until the last nation has passed by the Arrival Control and the final national hymn has been played. Participants may leave the Parc Fermé after this time. However, the Parc Fermé will remain secured until 16.30 pm.

Also at the end of the Nation Parade, 1st of July, a Parc Fermé is created at the finish location in centre of Liptovský Mikuláš. All motorcycles are secured from 11:00 AM until 4:00 PM

Reg. 12 Results and Classification

According to the CTG (Rally Art.15)

Reg. 13 Disqualifications

Participants shall be officially disqualified at the discretion of the Executive Committee if necessary.

Reg. 14 Prize Giving Ceremony

According to the FIM CTG (Rally Art. 25). This will take place on the evening of 1st July 2016. However, the FIM Meritum Junior and Inter-Club prizes will be awarded on the second evening.

Reg. 15 National Delegates

Each participating FMN has the right to nominate one delegate holder of a Tourism Steward's licence. The nomination shall be made in writing to the organiser at least 15 days before the event.

Reg. 16 Cancellation of the Event

According to the CTG (Rally Art.9).

The organiser can cancel the event:

- if, at the closing date, the number of entries is below 1000
- in the case of absolute necessity.

In the case of cancellation of the event, the participants who transmitted their entry forms before the closing entry date will be notified.

Reg. 17 General

Cancellation of registration

In case of individual registration cancelling, it shall be made by intermediary of the FMN of the participant and shall be transmitted to the organizer at the latest 30th April 2016. In this case 90% of the registration fee will be refunded. 50% will be refunded if cancellation is between the 1st of May and de 31st of May 2016.

SR - The English version of this document is always determinative.

Reg. 18 Responsibility of the participants

According to the CTG (Rally Art. 14) and Art. 19 (Touristic Gatherings of Category A). Also participants have to respect local authority regulations and the organisation "house-rules" during the event.

Reg. 19 Protection of the Environment

Participants of the FIM Rally are motorcyclist ambassadors for their country and are expected to consider other road users. (CTG Rally Art.3).

Conform to Article 11.2 of the Environment Code – Rider Conduct:

- Individual motorcyclists should develop riding habits to ensure full integration with other types of road users.
- Ride safely and avoid aggressive and competitive riding.
- Save petrol and reduce pollution by avoiding unnecessary idling of engines.
- Ride politely and limit noise pollution by using your horn only in an emergency.
- Noise annoyance. Use standard or another quiet exhaust system and keep audio systems at a low level.
- Use only routes which are open to motorcyclists.
- Ride like a professional by riding at a quiet and unobtrusive pace when riding in groups.
- Respect nature by not travelling on paths which risk being damaged beyond a point of natural recovery.
- Protect wildlife and its natural habitat by riding intelligently.
- Ensure that your used oil, tyres, batteries and other recyclable items are properly recycled.
- Encourages a rational use of fuel and space economy by using motorcycles instead of driving automobiles.
- Remember that our cities and our roads are not circuits.
